DG Visit to Coimbatore

- Dr. T. Mohapatra, Hon'ble Secretary DARE and Director General, ICAR, New Delhi visited Coimbatore during 31-10-2021 to 01-11-2021 and held discussion with the Scientists of ICAR Institutes located in Coimbatore. During the discussion, he emphasized the following points.
- 1. Nano urea fertiliser dose to be optimised for sugarcane & cotton
- 2. A mention of poly mulch demonstration by Cotton farmers at Aurangabad came in discussion: CICR Technology to be transferred to the farmers in a proactive manner. Validation and upscaling of available technology with the feedback from farmers need to be focused
- 3. Drip fertigation in cotton to be concentrated.
- 4. Organic cotton export potential, domestic production and research gaps need to be focused. The value chain for organic cotton involving producer industry exporter need to be studied.
- 5. POP for HDPS cotton in irrigated / rainfed conditions for different zone are to be optimised and communicated to stakeholders.
- 6. Success stories with economics and validated data should be communicated to council for the appraisal at PMO





On 01-11-2021, the DG was shown the performance of recently developed cotton culture CCH 19-4, which has ideal plant type suitable for High Density Planting System and Mechanical harvesting. He appreciated the same and emphasized that the large-scale demonstration of complete mechanization of cotton should be taken up on priority.
